UPPER ENDOSCOPY INSTRUCTIONS



You must arrive 1 hour before your scheduled time.

You cannot drive yourself home from the procedure. You must bring a responsible adult, 18 years old or older, to drive you home and sign discharge paperwork. Taxi, Uber, Lyft, or any rideshare service are not acceptable.

Instructions:

Diet:

1. Do not *eat* or *drink* anything for 12 hours prior to your procedure. This includes chewing gum, hard candy, or tobacco products for 12 hours prior to your procedure.

Medications:

- 1. You may take your usual medications with a sip of water 4 hours prior to the procedure unless instructed not to take a medication.
- 2. You may continue to take aspirin and anti-inflammatory medications such as Aleve, Advil, Motrin, Ibuprofen, Naproxen
- 3. You must **stop** taking any **injectable GLP-1 medications** for diabetes one week prior to your procedure. These include Trulicity, Byetta, Ozempic, Mounjaro, Victoza, and Lixisenatide
- 4. If you are on diabetic medications, please contact your prescribing physician for dosing changes since you will not be eating for 12 hours prior to your procedure.
- 5. You will need to **stop your blood thinners** prior to the procedure.

Stop 2 days prior: Apixaban, Eliquis, Dabigatran, Pradaxa, Edoxaban, Savaysa, Rivaroxaban, Xarelto

Stop 7 days prior: Warfarin, Coumadin, Fondaparinux, Clopidogrel, Plavix, Ticagrelor, Prasugrel, Effient, Dipyridamole, Persantine, Cilostazol, Pletal, Ticagrelor, Brilinta

Activity:

- 1. You cannot work the entire day of the procedure. You may return to work the following day.
- 2. You cannot drive a car, operate machinery including lawn equipment, sign legal documents, or engage in any activity that requires mental alertness or good judgment for the entire day after your procedure.
